A. Elementary School ASB Report

Eduardo Soto, ASB Vice-President reported that the 3<sup>rd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grades have been preparing for the new Smarter Balanced Test. It has not been easy but they are all getting through it. The middle schools had some successful basketball games against Maricopa and have a softball tournament coming up on May 9<sup>th</sup>. We have had the PCPA theater group perform for us and a few classes have been able to take field trips.

## VI. BOARD REPORTS:

Mr. Richard Ray reported that the Elementary School is now online with solar power, and the High School is expected to receive the switch needed to complete the solar installation on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of May, with the expectation of going online in approximately one week from date of installation. Mr. Ray also reported that he had received numerous phone calls from parents concerned about discontinuing the ASES program. Many parents offered to help in any way they can. Mr. Ray asked that we re-visit the issue at the special board meeting Thursday, May 17<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m.

## VII. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT:

Mr. Les Imel has been with us for approximately 3 ½ weeks. Mr. Imel stated that he was impressed with many things, but also sees many things that need work. At this time Mr. Imel is concerned with completing the LCAP, identifying goals and plans for the district. Expenditures need to coincide with programs and matching the items identified in the LCAP. The district will be sending out a survey to identify the needs, expectations and goals for the district, as expressed by educational groups, parents and community members. Mr. Imel met with Mr. Mike Limotta of Limotta IT and discussed where the district is at this time with technology and where we are headed for the future. The district will have computer labs completed at both schools before the end of June. We have received nine applications for the Math Teacher position at the High School. The district will conduct interviews in the next three to four weeks. Mr. Imel would like a hiring committee consisting of two teachers from the High School, one math teacher from the Elementary Middle School, the superintendent, and one Board Member.
