VIII. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT:

On behalf of students and staff of the Cuyama Joint Unified School District, Dr. Chounet read a resolution thanking Mr. Richard Ray for 12 years of service on the Cuyama Joint Unified School District's Governing Board. A gift certificate for \$200 value at a fishing destination of Mr. Ray's choice was presented by Dr. Chounet.

Dr. Chounet reported that the Ag Department is preparing to plant barley, and setting up the irrigation system for the field. The bed on the old Ford truck was removed, and the truck taken to Westside ROP in Taft, to be repaired and painted. There will be someone from Cal Poly in SLO coming to look at, evaluate, and make suggestions of improvement for the greenhouse at the High School. Mr. Lebsack will continue managing the orchard. The football team won the league championship. The volleyball team played well, but did not make play-offs. Basketball practice for both boys and girls has started. ASES enrollment is up, with the ADA reaching 36. The program needs another activity leader to handle the increase in students. The district is in Title III Program Improvement, with a rough draft of an improvement plan being prepared. The valley experienced a severe storm Thursday night, resulting in cancellation of the Winter Program and the regular Board Meeting. School was cancelled Friday, due to storm damage and electrical outage. The district called a claim into SISC for damage, and brought Service Master, out of Bakersfield to complete clean-up. Dr. Chounet is preparing a waiver to the state for lost ADA due to school closure. Mrs. Goller, Mrs. Harrington, and Mrs. Cole will be going to Ontario for Powerschool training on January 12, 13, and 14th.

Mr. Matt Stowell conducted an informal meeting and discussion last Tuesday with the ELAC and DLAC committees. The LCAP will determine funding. We are six months into the LCAP, and about 20% complete with the 3 year implementation. The district is on target.

4. Olive Grove Charter School Update Petition was submitted in October, the district agreed to take the next 90 days to look into the possibility of sponsoring the Charter, with an answer being given in January. The district would have oversight and receive a % of the Charter's revenue, and help with independent programs. Sponsoring the Charter will not interfere with the designation of our High School as a Necessary Small School. The District is a direct service SELPA. The Charter has located El Dorado Charter SELPA, a SELPA that they can be included in. In-Lieu taxes could create a cash flow problem if the district is required to pay monthly.
